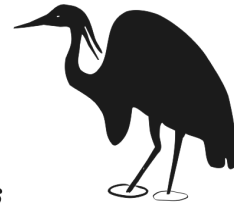

The program is an armchair trip to Antarctica by way of Buenos Aires and Ushuaia presented by Bob Diefenbacher who joined a Lindblad National Geographic expedition to the Antarctic Peninsula in December 2011. The trip was to visit and learn about the Great White Continent, and to photograph the landscape and wildlife. The show includes a brief PowerPoint introduction and then a “Ken Burns” style presentation. Bob will bring some prints from the show as well as maps and materials that provide more detail about his exciting adventure.

## Notes from November Meeting

Dave Mangels presented stunning images from a variety of locations in Utah and Arizona, including Canyonlands and Arches National Parks, Dead Horse State Park, Cedar Mesa, and Antelope Canyon. By popular demand after that, he shared some of his work from a recent trip to Iceland as well.

Much of Dave’s work is the result of converting color images to black and white, primarily using Nik Silver Effects Pro. He shoots with a Canon EOS 60D, and makes only limited use of high dynamic range (HDR) techniques.
